

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1

A person is reported **missing** to the police and is believed to be living with **dementia**.

2

The police call **MedicAlert's 24/7 emergency helpline** on 0207 407 2818, providing the individual's surname and postcode.

3

Our team carries out a **quick validation process** and searches the **secure database** using the information provided.

4

If a Herbert Protocol is stored, it is immediately sent as a **PDF** to a **secure** and **verified** police email address.

5

Post incident, a MedicAlert **nurse** calls the individual/their carer to follow-up and identify record changes and signposting to partner support.



What Is The Herbert Protocol?
The Herbert Protocol is a national safeguarding scheme used by police forces and emergency services across the UK to support people living with dementia or other cognitive challenges who might be at risk of becoming lost or reported as missing.

MedicAlert's national digital database now securely stores this information, making it easily accessible to police and emergency services.




