

Unexpected Death of a Child

PRUDiC Phase One
(within 0-5 days)

- 1. INFORMATION SHARING & PLANNING MEETING:**
- Held within two working days
 - Case considered for CPR referral

Police Lead sends **initial notification** to RSB Business Unit with:

Name of child, Date of birth, Date of death, Cause of death, Date of Case Discussion Meeting, Local Authority Area

PRUDiC Phase Two
(within 5-28 days)

- 2. CASE DISCUSSION MEETING:**
- Police arrange for most relevant person/agency to fill out Child Death Notification (CDN) form
 - CDN is sent to RSB Business Unit by most relevant person/agency, as arranged
 - Case considered for CPR referral

RSB Business Unit sends CDN to Public Health Wales Child Death Review Programme

PRUDiC Phase Three
(within 12 months)

- 3. CASE REVIEW MEETING:**
- Police arrange for most relevant person/agency to fill out Case Summary
 - CDR is sent to RSB Business Unit by most relevant person/agency, as arranged
 - Case considered for CPR

RSB Business Unit sends Case Summary to Public Health Wales Child Death Review Programme

CPR Sub Group monitor the progress of each PRUDiC process and ensure that timescales are met. Any exceptions will be reported to the Board.
