

<u>Social Media a</u> major asset

The UK is the largest consumer of Extremist content online in Europe.

The threat is evolving. The growing threat of far right terrorism, plus an evolving and increasingly sophisticated far right presence online, driving anti-Muslim propaganda and conspiracy theories.

Today's key activists tend to be younger, operate online and are men. Men are significantly more likely than women to produce online hate material.

A younger generation of activists, using social media and video to mobilise supporters.

With increasingly negative views towards British Muslims – and Islam– there is a growing pool of possible recruits for the far right and, with some now having ways to reach people that were unimaginable in the past.

Particular social networking sites, such as Reddit and General Messaging Boards, are positively related to the dissemination of online hate material



Driving Factors of Change -Social Media; A Major Asset for Extremists Fringe & Mainstream Platforms

- Censorship free
- Many Creators support far right positions
- Upload content freely avoiding rules enforced on other platforms Moderation is slim to zero
- Brenton Tarrant posted manifesto on 8-CHan
- Mutually self reinforcing echo chamber no counter narrative, no positive viewpoint
- XRW show some respect for Islamist extremists for their dedication, courage, brutality and commitment to their cause
- Effects of pandemic ? Will play out in months /years ahead



Court Proceedings

The trial court heard from the prosecution how :-

- 1. LG had become radicalised over the internet
- 2. He had terrorist material stored on his computer
- 3. He published posts on Instagram which encouraged terrorism
- 4. He was planning a 'lone actor' style attack in the name of Islam

Counsel Matthew Brook opening note to trial...

"Lloyd Gunton I suspect, does not look like how you expected a terrorist to look."

Founder of Proscribed Organisation <u>National Action</u>

Sentenced at Winchester Crown Court on 7th June 2022

Received 8 years and 6 months imprisonment

National Action described themselves as a White Jihadist Group.



The group spread its propaganda through stickering, leafleting and joining flash demonstrations, mostly notably in 2016 in Liverpool, Swansea, York and Darlington.

COLUMBINE School Massacre Ideology

- 20th April 1999 Columbine High School Massacre: Colorado
- 13 Murdered (12 students 1 teacher) and more than 20 wounded
- 2 perpetrators then committed suicide
 - Precise motives unclear ... members of a group of social outcasts called the Trenchcoat Mafia, fascinated by Goth culture.
 - Indication they wished to rival the Oklahoma City Bombing and other deadly incidents in the USA.
 - Retaliation for being bullied at school ?
 - Influenced by Violent Video games + Music?

Depicted with large jaws, wellendowed, with chiselled features.





PILL THEORIES


Incels regularly reference blue, red and black pills.

The terms "red pill" and "blue pill" refer to a choice between the willingness to learn a potentially unsettling or life-changing truth, by taking the red pill, and remaining in contented ignorance with the blue pill. (These terms refer to a scene in the Matrix film)

Blue Pill: The world the naïve wider society live in, oblivious to the real truth and taking comfort in blissful ignorance.

Red Pill: The 'real truth' –the idea that society discriminates against men. Women empowered by feminism, contrary to incel view that women are commodities with no value unless sexually available to men.

Black Pill: Developed nihilistic view, beyond Red Pill revelation –one of hopelessness and fatalism where attempts at personal improvement are ineffective. Incels commonly consider themselves black pilled.



PEPE the frog – common meme amongst many online subcultures – used by white supremacists to pass negative stereotypes. Popular in INCEL community.




Mixed Unclear Unstable Ideologies

- Mixed: individuals who show interest in several ideologies simultaneously. For example, a joint interest in right-wing extremism and involuntary celibate ("incel") content or Islamist extremism and white supremacy.
- Unstable: individuals who initially appear to adhere solely to one ideology but then switch or transition to another.
- Unclear: individuals whose ideological influences are less coherent and not easily identifiable. This can include individuals motivated by a hatred of a 'perceived other' without relating to prominent, well-known forms of extremism. This includes but is not limited to those who appear fixated with mass violence (such as school shootings) and incels, whose intolerance is predominantly directed at women











Behavioural indicators of Vulnerability

- Need for identity, meaning or belonging
- Need for excitement and adventure
- Need to dominate others
- Opportunistic Offending
- Need to defend against threats
- Political Moral motivation
- Need to redress injustice or express grievance
- Family or community support for extremist ideology
- Transitional periods
- Group Control or Influence
- Mental illness or personality disorder
- Us and them thinking
- Dehumanisation of the enemy
- Attitudes that justify offending
- Disinformation/ Conspiracies
- Accelerationist material desensitisation

Self-Initiated Terrorism (SI-T)

(Lone Wolf Attacker)

'Person(s) who threaten or mobilise to violence (as defined in s1 TACT 2000) without material support or personal direction from a terrorist organisation; but who may still be influenced or encouraged by the rhetoric or ideology of a group'



Attacks have increased significantly in recent years; reflecting a trend towards low-complexity terror attacks.



The threat from Self–Initiated Terrorist attacks is a national priority. Early identification is key.

Self-Initiated Terrorists can act alone, but are they really alone? They are part of society, with neighbours, colleagues, case workers, family members and even friends.

.... often **less secretive** than expected, and generally **someone will know** of their intentions, beliefs grievances or extremist ideology due to "**leakage**".



Self-Initiated Terrorism (SI-T)

(Lone Wolf Attacker)

Key behaviours to look out for -

Indicators

- Commitment to the role:
 - A sense that something must be done, and they will be the one to do it.
 - May increasingly see themselves as 'warriors', 'defenders', or 'martyrs'.



- Increasingly fixated on a grievance and target, such as fixated on an individual, or on weapons or explosives. Traumatic event?
- Testing legitimacy of violence and exploring other options. Have they voiced a grievance to anyone?



Developing

Capability

- Developing skills and knowledge and deciding on tactics. Military training? Specialist skills (eg demolition)? Violent history?
- Identifying and sourcing resources.
- Developing psychological capacity to act.
- · Favouring low sophistication methods.



Planning & Preparing for an attack



- Acquiring resources and material needed, carrying out reconnaissance, practicing for an attack (improving fitness, playing computer games to develop combat skills and psychological readiness).
- Getting psychologically ready i.e. changes in behaviour/demeanour.
- Making final preparations:
 - Trying to tie up loose ends (such as paying off debts, closing bank accounts etc.).
 - May show signs of farewell behaviours e.g. writing a will, saying goodbye to family and friends.
 - May make threats online or public pronouncements for having no alternative but to act.

 Not all Self-Initiated Terrorists will necessarily display all of the above behaviour categories as they are
 interchangeable, and can follow any order. This is not exhaustive.

Reporting preferences

The first people to suspect or know about someone becoming radicalised will often be those closest to them: their friends, family and community insiders. These 'intimates' have a vital role to play against potential terrorist threats and offer a first line of defence
